This Pledge is a tool to create a network of resistance against Federal and local police actions that would deprive patients of their rights to medical marijuana. Nonviolent direct action (NVDA) can include risking arrest & conviction in actions such as sit-ins, blockades, banner hangs etc... that do not harm or dehumanize other people.

Support can mean financial support, court support, prison support. It can mean taking part in vigils and demonstrations, holding public meetings or letter-writing to decision-makers.
